The Ryan Gibson Foundation is seeking proposals from the top leukemia focused researchers in the country. Founded in 2001, The Foundation has focused on funding “basic science” research. Past grant recipients have included UT Southwestern, Baylor College of Medicine, UAMS, MD Anderson, Sloan-Kettering and Cold Springs Harbor.

The Foundation has the same goal as you, a cure for leukemia. We believe that basic science researchers do not get the attention they deserve and thus funding at times can also be limited. To date we have only funded basic science research and we plan on continuing that mission.

We have typically granted \$50,000 as this tends to be adequate for most projects in their infancy, but if there is a greater need, we would certainly consider it. We ask for the following basic information in order to be considered.

1. Hypothesis
2. Specific Aims / Goals
3. Background / Preliminary Data (if available)
4. Experimental Plan
5. Related Clinical Studies (if any)
6. Timeline
7. Basic Budget
  - Researcher’s Salary & Percentage of Time on this project
  - Lab Expenses (if any)
  - Equipment Expenses
  - Other Indirect Costs
